

WILL IT FIT?

We want to ensure your new furniture fits perfectly in your home, so we've created a handy checklist to run through before your delivery arrives.

STEP 1: Check the measurements

As the majority of our products come in boxes, **you will need to know the dimensions of the packages** in order to check whether they will fit. You will find these on the product page of our website under 'Dimensions' in the 'Assembly and Packaging' tab. **Add the dimensions of your items to the box on the right.**

STEP 2: Check the route

Walk the route your new furniture will take, starting **from our delivery van to your chosen room**. Make sure you take into account any potential pinch points, such as garden gates, front doors and stairwells. Remove any obstacles, including furniture, mirrors, artwork or stair gates, to protect your home. **Add measurements of your home in the sections below, and compare these against the widest and tallest items** you added in the measurements box above.

Some items are delivered in more than one package to make it easier to get them into your home, so always check what the dimensions of each box will be.

YOUR ROOM OF CHOICE

Use masking tape to mark out the measurements of your new furniture on the floor to double-check its size and proportions.

IS THERE A LIFT?

If our delivery team will have to use a lift to access your property, this will also need to be measured.

Check the **internal width, height and depth** of the lift and ensure these measurements are greater than the largest item.

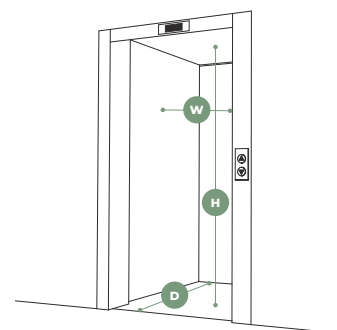
And, don't forget to **check if there's a weight restriction** in the lift.

POTENTIAL PROBLEM AREAS

The key measurements to take are outlined below:

1 DOORWAYS

Take the narrowest measurement of the inside of the door frame and the height. As boxes can be rotated, check the width of the box is smaller than the width of the gap and the height of the box is smaller than the height of the gap.

2 OBSTRUCTIONS

Don't forget that radiators, shelves, door handles, handrails and wall fixtures can cause obstructions. In tighter spaces, ensure doors are opened as wide as possible and measure the smallest internal gap.

3 STAIRWAYS & TIGHT TURNS

Check the width of your stairs at their narrowest point and make sure the width of your box is smaller than it. If you have tight corners, check that the floor to ceiling height is bigger than the height of your item. Don't forget to measure the angle from the floor to the lowest part of the bulkhead and ensure the height of the item is less.

4 OBSTACLES

Don't forget to measure any fixed obstacles, such as lights or wall or floor fixtures, that may interfere with your delivery.

5 INTERNAL DOORS & HALLWAYS

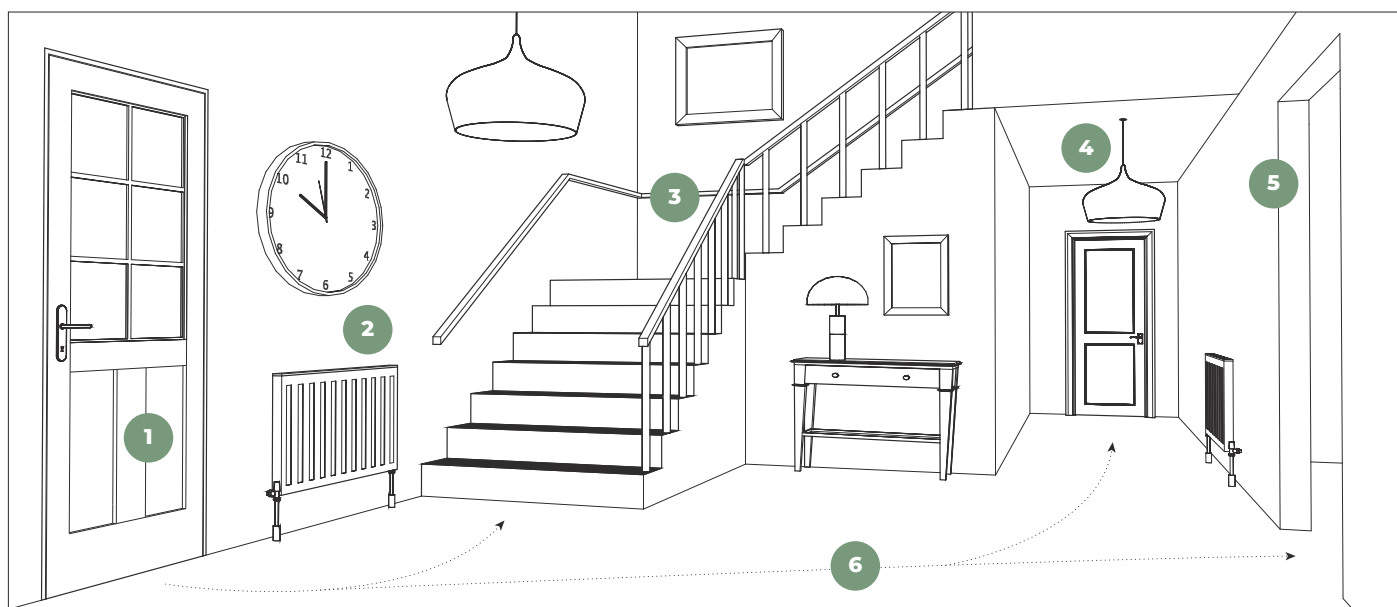
Ensure items can fit into your room of choice by measuring all internal doors and door frames. And make sure to measure the height, width and depth of your hallway to check there's enough room to manoeuvre your furniture.

6 A CLEAR PATH

Make space in the room to position your new furniture and don't forget to create enough space if some home assembly is required. Cover your floor prior to delivery to prevent any accidental scuffs.

Make sure you have someone to help you move and/or assemble any furniture

Please note that our delivery team are not permitted to lift our large/extra large items above waist height due to their weight, so please ensure that you have considered this when measuring up your home.
